The PFLCC will be holding a Priority Resource & Conservation Target Identification Workshop, 11/28/16-12/2/16 in Orlando. The PFLCC partnership is working to develop a set of Conservation Targets (or indicators) for selected Priority Resources, which are the measurable expressions of the desired future conditions. Species and habitat experts are being requested to participate in a series of half day sessions to identify conservation targets for coastal uplands, high pine & scrub, pine flatwoods & dry prairie, hardwood forested uplands, working lands, freshwater aquatic (rivers, lakes, springs), freshwater forested wetlands, freshwater non-forested wetlands and landscape connectivity. A similar workshop will be scheduled at a later date for Marine and Estuarine Priority Resources in order to align with other ongoing efforts. The PFLCC is conducting this assessment for the entire state of Florida.
