- Established as a direct result of the attacks of September 11th and the October anthrax attacks in Boca Raton
- Tampa Bay is known as RDSTF IV, made up of 8 counties.
- Multi-disciplinary group made of public and private sector partners.

RDSTF Impact

- Is the regional coordinating body for plans and procedures.
- Is moving from terrorism based to all-hazards to lessen current burden on emergency responders.
 - Prioritization of Regional Priorities
 - Identification of critical infrastructure and key resources
 - Common Operating Picture protocol
 - Establishment of Regional Reentry Protocols before, during, and post incident.
