# CCSH/TBRPC History

- 10/01 TBRPC Adopted a policy to encourage Scenic Highways within the region
- 10/02 TBRPC Agreed to become CCSH's **Corridor Management Entity**
- Designation Approval by Florida Secretary of Transportation May 23, 2005
- 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Rededication

  - Rollerblading






