Agenda

1. Welcome and Introductions
2. HB 1359 -Coastal High Hazard Area - Discussion continues regarding the implications of the recent legislation (HB 1359) and the new definition of the Coastal High Hazard Area (CHHA) and required adoption of an Evacuation Time LOS. Storm Surge Category 1 (One), as derived from the SLOSH model, is the primary delineation of the CHHA. According to DCA, HB 1359 does not allow local governments latitude in adjusting the CHHA. The map must be adopted as published in the Storm Tide Atlas (2006). Local governments are encouraged to apply the policies related to the CHHA to other areas where appropriate, such as communities connected to the mainland by bridges or where access would be significantly restricted in a major storm. The discussion will focus on specific policies which should be expanded and where it might be appropriate . It is hoped that consistent recommendations can be developed for use region wide. Copies of the *Executive Summary* of the Evacuation Study (clearance times) and electronic copies of the *Tampa Bay Region Hurricane Evacuation Study Update 2006* (RHES) will be distributed.
3. Abbreviated Transportation Model - As part of the 2006 RHES, Post Buckley Shuh and Jernigan, Inc. (PBS&J) developed an abbreviated transportation model (ATM) which can be used to quantify impacts to shelter and clearance time of changes in the land use and density within the evacuation zones. Mr. Bob Collins of PBS&J will demonstrate how to use the model. You are encouraged to bring your laptop to the meeting. The ATM will be available to download.
