The next regular meeting of the Regional Planning Advisory Committee is scheduled for **1:30 p.m. on Friday, April 7th** in the Council's Conference Room. Due to the inclement weather on February 3rd, the agenda below is similar to February's but with updated information to be presented.

Agenda

1. TBRPC staff have been tasked, as an EPA sub-grantee, to complete a sea level rise study that seeks to identify potential land use impacts within the region based on sea level rise data (estimates) provided by EPA. A most critical component of the study will be incorporation of local planner input, especially in identifying the likelihood of land use protection. RPC staff will give a brief overview of the study and present the first draft of the Anticipated Response Maps.
