The next regular meeting of the Regional Planning Advisory Committee will be held at 1:30 p.m. on Friday, October 6th in the Council's Conference Room. The primary item of business will be the discussion of HB 1359 and the delineation of the Coastal High Hazard Area.

Agenda

1. Welcome and Introductions
2. HB 1359 -Coastal High Hazard Area - Staff will lead a discussion regarding the implications of the recent legislation (HB 1359) regarding the new Coastal High Hazard Area (CHHA) and Evacuation Time LOS on local land development regulations, mitigation strategies and public safety. Storm Surge Category 1 (One) , as derived from the SLOSH model, is the primary delineation of the CHHA. HB 1359 allows for some local government latitude in adjusting the CHHA. The discussion will focus on what criteria should be used when "local adjustments" are made. It is hoped that consistent criteria can be developed for use region wide. Copies of the Executive Summary of the Evacuation Study (clearance times) will be distributed.
3. Roundtable - Please be prepared to discuss the exciting planning initiatives underway in your community and/or concerns with implementing any of the numerous new state planning requirements.
