

BASIS 6: Guide for Authors

Where appropriate, please follow the standard formatting specified for article submissions to the *Estuarine, Coastal and Shelf Science* Journal described [here](#).

Deviations from this standard formatting are listed below.

Title Page

Please submit your paper with a 1-page title page that includes the following information:

Title—Include the final title name for the BASIS 6 presentation that the paper addresses.

Author names and affiliations—Present the authors' affiliation addresses below the names. Indicate all affiliations with a lower-case superscript letter immediately after the author's name and in front of the appropriate address. Provide the full postal address of each affiliation and e-mail address of each author.

Abstract— Include the final 300-word abstract submitted for the BASIS 6 presentation that the paper addresses.

General Body

Please limit the body of your paper to 10 pages of 1.5-spaced text with a minimum, 11-point font typeface. Margins should be at a minimum of 1". Appropriate subsections of the paper are at the discretion of the author and should include a brief heading (e.g., Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion, References, etc.). Abbreviations and units should be clearly defined upon first use and held standard throughout the paper (i.e., consistently use either metric or English units throughout the document).

Tables and Figures

Up to five additional pages of tables, figures or graphics can accompany the general body of the paper. Captions should be concise and referenced in your paper appropriately. Graphics and figures should be at least 300dpi.

Submittal Format

Please submit the complete paper as one MS Word file using the following naming convention:

[Primary Author Last Name]-[First 3 words of title with underscores]-[submittal date in MM-DD-YY format].doc

For example: *Sherwood-2006_Tidal_Tributary-12-04-15.doc*
