## 2. The Cost of Doing Nothing

Presenter: Randy Deshazo, Tampa Bay Regional Planning Council  
TBRPC is preparing to release *The Cost of Doing Nothing: An Economic Impact Study of Climate Change Related Submerged Land in the Tampa Bay Area*. Sea level rise is a threat to the Tampa Bay area economy. TBRPC has modeled potential impacts of “doing nothing” on the Tampa Bay economy. Randy Deshazo will discuss the long run impacts of sea level rise on the region’s economy.

## 3. Updates to Storm Surge Inundation Maps

Presenter: Brady Smith, Tampa Bay Regional Planning Council  
The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Meteorological Development Laboratory has released the outputs of the most up-to-date SLOSH model for the Tampa Bay region. This latest SLOSH model output indicates that the region’s potential worst-case storm surge inundation areas have increased in areal coverage since the last SLOSH update in the late 2000s. Brady Smith will show the latest storm surge inundation maps that have been created for the Tampa Bay region so far, and discuss the potential implications of the new maps on hurricane evacuation and other related issues.
