## GREETINGS & INTRODUCTIONS:

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jonson at 10:05 a.m. Introductions were made.

## PUBLIC COMMENTS:

No members of the public were present.

## OLD BUSINESS:

3. Upon a motion by Mr. Hoyt and seconded by Mr. Gregory, the summary of the May 16, 2014 meeting was approved.
4. The committee agreed to revise Goal 4, Objective a. to include a strategy to seek funding to support web enhancement and maintenance. The committee also discussed inviting the URS web team and the various CVBs to attend an upcoming meeting. Additionally, it was determined that the Wikipedia entry for the Courtney Campbell Scenic Highway should be monitored and updated.
5. Ms. Leonard reported that the trail construction is currently on time/slightly ahead of schedule. She also reported that the Ream Wilson trail connection is at 50% design and will include revised cost estimates to reduce the number of road crossings. The committee also discussed supporting a formal request letter to the Pinellas MPO to request matching funds for the City of Clearwater Courtney Campbell Trail amenities package.
6. There was no update from the City of Tampa.

## OTHER BUSINESS:

The committee noted that the George Road feasibility study has a new consultant but does not look like it is moving forward. The Westshore Alliance is planning an annual branding event and is consulting with the Sports Commission. The annual event may coincide with the 100<sup>th</sup>

anniversary of the City of Clearwater's founding and the completion of the second half of the trail.

The next meeting is scheduled for August 22<sup>nd</sup>. The meeting adjourned at 11:15 a.m.
