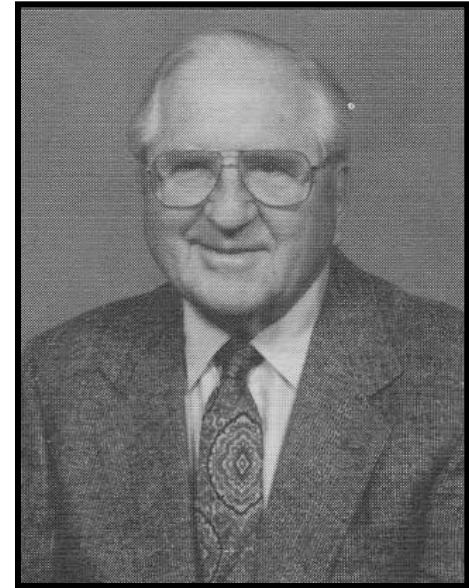

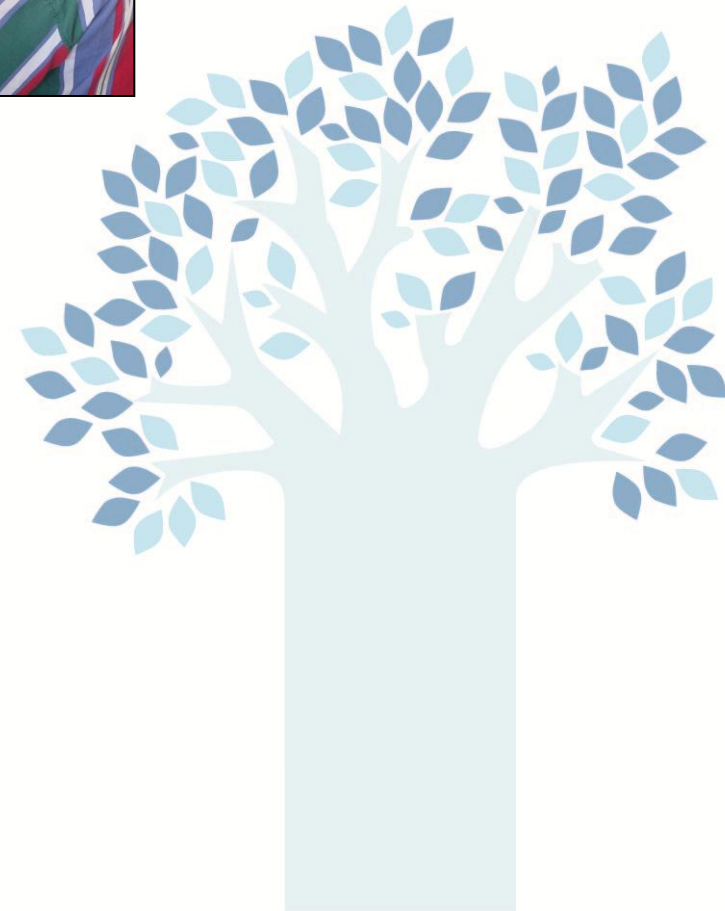

Mixed-Use Trip Reduction Measures (MUTRM) Pasco County



MUTRM provides the development community a means of achieving a greater density/intensity of development, while addressing identified transportation impacts through an alternative, more urban, development pattern.



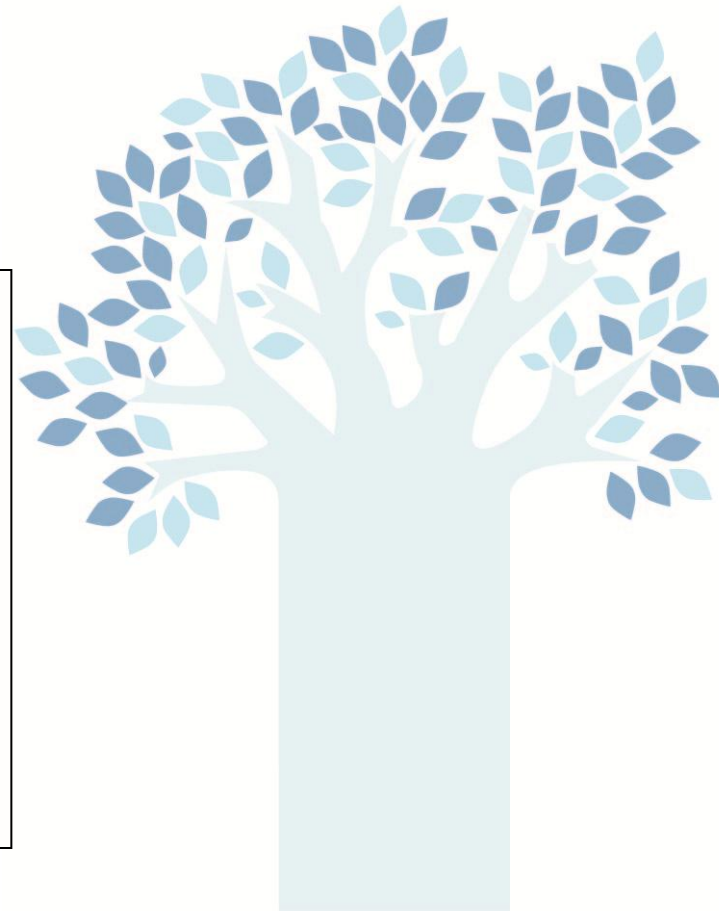
MUTRM requirements establish an interconnected roadway and pedestrian system that provides a framework for development to grow over time within the same network.



MUTRM emphasizes roadway and pedestrian connectivity, multimodal options, increased density and intensity of a site, and mixed-use options for developers.



MUTRM allows for both physical and economic growth, while minimizing the transportation impacts in an external development, and collector and arterial roadways.

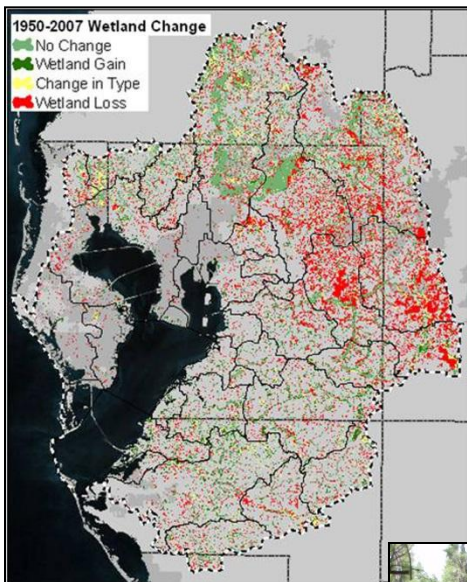

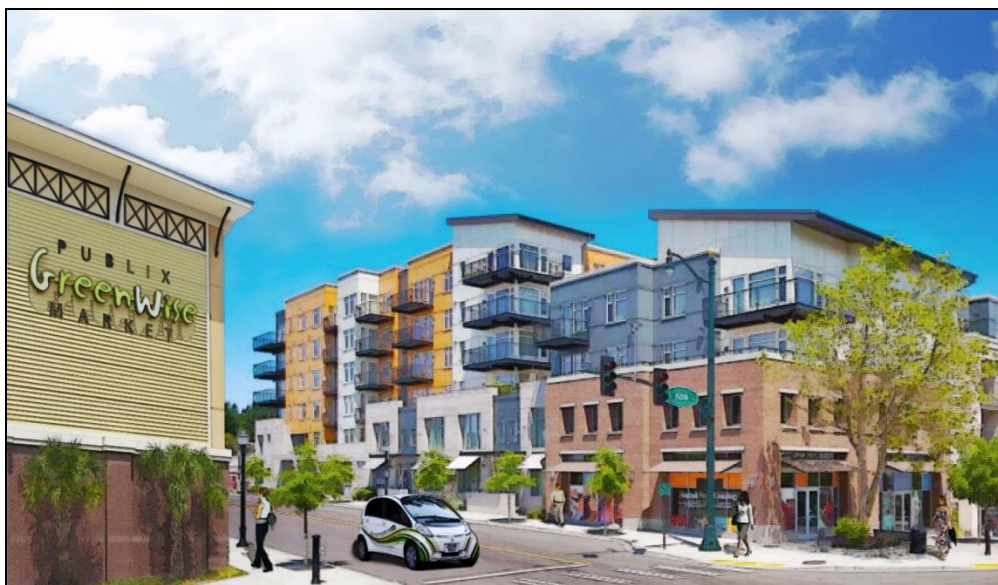
